# Choices



Deuteronomy 30:19 “I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendents may live.” All of us make hundreds of choices each day. Every choice we make, affects our future whether that is the next 3 hours or the next 3 years. We can all look back at our lives and pinpoint good choices and bad choices.
